Surgical technologists work under the supervision of surgeons to promote a safe surgical environment. During surgery, technologists assist surgeons before during and after procedures. The work requires paying close attention to details, remaining calm under pressure, and staying focused.

Three reasons to consider this program.

1. Every surgery is different. No two days on the job will be the same.
2. Patients in surgery can feel scared. You help them feel comfortable. Your time with patients makes a difference.
3. Roane State has a state-of-the-art surgical technology lab.

Before you sign up, make sure you understand...

1. Surgical techs are part of teams, which means they must communicate well. Courses such as English and speech can improve your communication skills.
2. Being in surgery means wearing a mask for extended periods of time and seeing a lot of blood.
3. Admission is competitive. The typical GPA for accepted students is about 3.2 and only 15 spots are available.

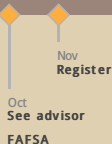

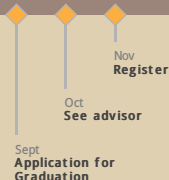
